

Nick Indahl College Scholarship Fund Annual Report for 2018

Mission Statement

- Provide financial assistance to Gloria Dei's post secondary students
- Provide a continuing connection to the church after students graduate from high school

2018 marked the fourteenth year for the scholarship fund, founded in 2005 in memory of Nick Indahl.

In the past 14 years, 73 recipients have received a total of \$159,500 in college scholarship monies. Recipients from 2005-2013 each received \$1000. In 2014, the committee voted to award \$1000 to college freshmen and sophomores and \$1500 to those who had attained junior or senior status. In 2016, the committee voted to award \$1500 to all successful applicants.

Each successful scholarship applicant must be an active member of Gloria Dei; attend an accredited, post-secondary institution; and write a faith statement. In addition, recipients must complete fifteen hours of volunteer work at Gloria Dei or Lutheran Social Services of Alaska.

Two sources—various events and individual contributions—support the scholarship fund. Although there were no official fundraisers in 2018, past events include a dinner and talent show, five fall harvest auctions, four holiday bazaars, and several raffles.

As of December 31, 2018, the scholarship fund had investments in Vanguard Investment Company as well as a cash reserve in Northrim Bank.
